

### DESCRIBE THE FEATURED PROJECT.

This 5-bedroom, 31/2-bath, Santa Barbara Spanish-style beauty was created by brothers Patrick Cunningham, AIA, and Michael Cunningham, GC, owner-operators of C&C Partners Design Build, in collaboration with architect Tom Rule, AIA. The clients accompanied Patrick on a walking tour of Santa Barbara to identify the Spanish architectural details of the city's unique structures so they could then be reflected in the home. styles, roof tiles, wrought iron and gutters were a love letter to Santa Barbara.

The 4,302-square-foot dwelling boasts Brazilian walnut hardwood floors throughout, with Spanish revival-inspired, wrought iron details in doorways, culminating in the gate at the entrance to the dining room. The kitchen features marble countertops, an island with a built-in wine cellar and an antique brick stove alcove. Bathrooms contain Carrara marble and glass tile.

The centerpiece of the backyard is the pergola, which includes seating, fireplace, custom tile artwork inspired by the Van Cleef Alhambra collection, and a mosaic tile wall fountain imported from Morocco. All the elements work together to create a calming space for contemplation or conversation.
